

COMMUNITY UPDATE – July 2018

Works for Wynyard Place will continue throughout July, with the following underway:

Construction Activities

- The concrete building form for the new transit hall and supporting tower structure continues through the month.
- Heritage façade investigation works for Shell House will progress during the month. Colour matching and procurement of the faience façade tiles (i.e. the façade of Shell House) are the next steps.
- Structural internal demolition is progressing in Shell House. It is anticipated to reach level 1 by the end of July.
- Construction of the Shell House basement permitter ground beam will be completed this month.
- The northern buttress walls will be completed by the end of July.

Pedestrian and vehicle access changes

- At the end of July, the Wynyard Place project will transition from the existing pedestrian access route to George Street into a new refurbished pedestrian access route to George Street (Phase 3). This change will remain in place until Wynyard Place is completed in mid-2020.
- As part of the pedestrian access route transition and in order to provide a refreshed, accessible, and
 modernised pedestrian access from Wynyard Station through to the Hunter Connection and Hunter
 Arcade, the tunnel under George Street will be temporarily closed from 27 July 2018 for
 approximately 12 months. The closure is necessary for safety reasons. Access into the Hunter
 Arcade and Hunter Connection will continue via Hunter Street, George Street, and Pitt Street
 entrances.
- Vehicular crossing of the footpath on Carrington Street to access the site will continue throughout July. New traffic and pedestrian controls (i.e. barriers and operational staff) have been implemented to manage pedestrian safety.
- Margaret Street works zone is operational from 7.00am to 7.00pm Monday to Friday and 7.00am to 5.00pm on Saturdays.
- Hours of use of the Carrington Street works zone are 7:00am to 7:00pm Monday to Friday, and 7.00am to 5.00pm Saturdays. The works zone reverts back to a taxi rank outside of these hours. Access for non-construction vehicles from the southern end of Wynyard Lane will be maintained throughout the project.
- Customers requiring an accessible route to Wynyard Station via the George Street entry/exit will
 need to use the alternative routes as shown on page 3 for the first six months. Wayfinding staff will
 be present during the initial period of change to assist customers with these new arrangements.



Existing Access to Wynyard Station




New Access to Wynyard Station
